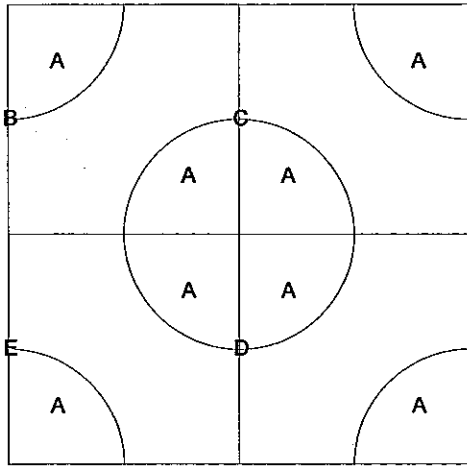
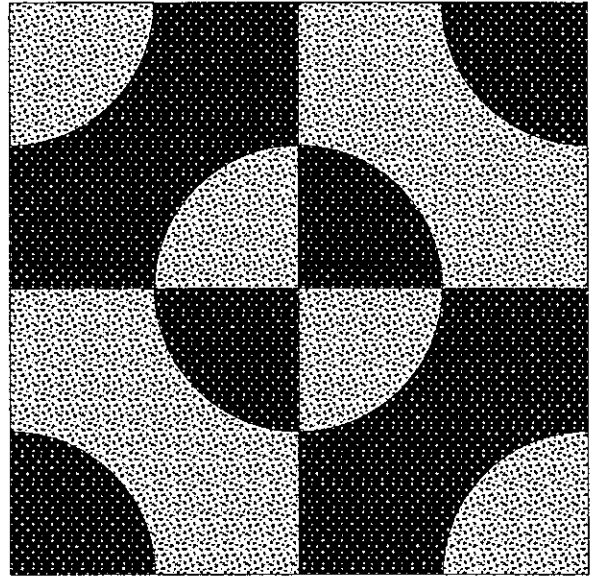

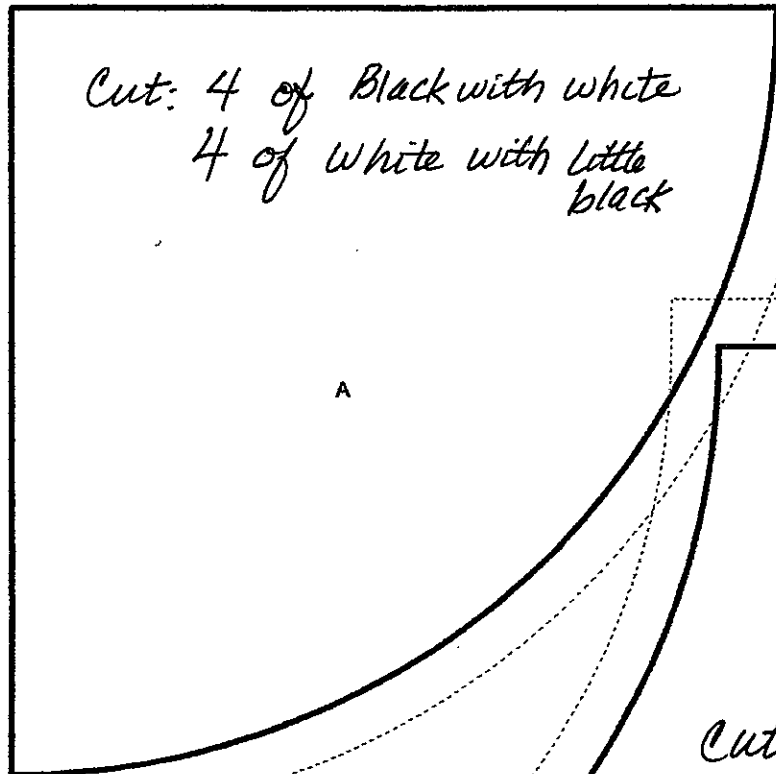
Key Block (3/20 actual size)

4 of White with little black

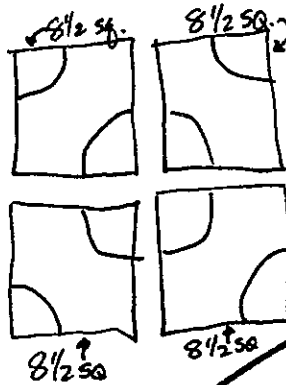
